RE: Price Guidance

As we move through the Fourth Quarter 2020, we wanted to give you some guidance on what we see from the manufacturers on material pricing.

The steel manufacturers announced price increases in October and have another increase announced for late November. Foreign trade policies are cited for the increases in raw steel pricing.

From our gypsum vendors, we had an increase in October, and we have seen announcements of a January 2021 price increase as well. The strength in the residential sector has push capacity rates at or above 90%. That is essentially full capacity and the reason why controlled distribution has been implemented nationwide. Other factors that add to this move are the shutdown of some older plants, the significant increases in gypsum ingredients (i.e., Vermiculite), and the burden all vendors have currently with trucking costs.

We have summarized the expected January 2021 increases below:
